RESOLUTION NO. 2017-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SOUTH KENDALL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DECLARING VACANCIES ON THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 190.006(3)(b), FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 190.006, Florida Statutes, members of the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") of the South Kendall Community Development District (the "District") are to be elected by the qualified electors of the District at a general election held in November; and

WHEREAS, the District provided notice of the qualifying period for election to the District Board at least two (2) weeks prior to the start of the qualifying period, as required by Section 190.006(3)(b), Florida Statutes,; and

WHEREAS, the **Miami-Dade** County Elections Department has confirmed that at the close of the qualifying period for election to the District Board, no electors qualified for <u>Seat # 3 & Seat #5</u> to be filled in the general election to be held on November 08, 2016 (the "General Election"); and

WHEREAS, the District is required by section 190.006(3)(b), Florida Statutes, to declare the seat to be filled by the election to which no qualified elector has qualified as vacant and to appoint a qualified elector to fill such vacancy within 90 days of the second Tuesday following the General Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE SOUTH KENDALL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, THAT:

- 1. The recitals above are true and correct and are hereby made a part of this Resolution.
- 2. The Board hereby declares <u>Seat # 3 & Seat #5</u> to be vacant, effective on the second Tuesday following the General Election.

- 3. The Board shall appoint a qualified elector to Seat # 3 & Seat # 5 within 90 days of the second Tuesday following the General Election, as required by Section 190.006(3)(b), Florida Statutes. Until such appointment to a seat, the incumbent board member in such seat shall remain in office.
- 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.

Approval of Minutes of the October 28, 2016 Meeting
